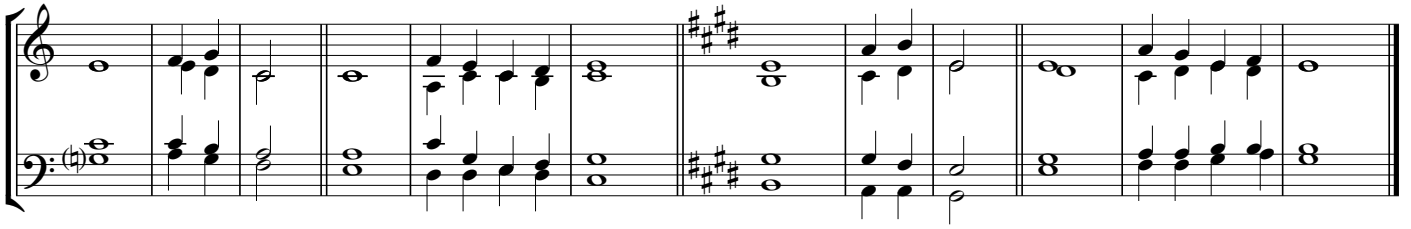


# Psalm 31
